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What is autism?


- A set of heterogeneous neurodevelopmental conditions
- 1% of adult population medically diagnosed (UK)
- Aetiology contested
- No known cure

- Disclaimer: Pro-medical diagnosis












Where I would rather prefer to be * choose the most likely option


Research Questions

- 1) Why do people seek a diagnosis of autism in adulthood?
- 2) What determines whether they diagnose themselves (lay diagnosis) or seek a medical diagnosis?





Method: Sampling



Recruitment:

- Charity organisations (e.g. National Autistic Society)
- Online networks (e.g. Autistic Pride)



Method: Data Collection

Data collection

- Semi-structured interviews (30-40)
- Online interviews/chatroom discussions









Contribution & Output



- Transformative power of diagnosis
- Sociological perspective on autism diagnosis
- Message for clinicians
- Transferability to other conditions
